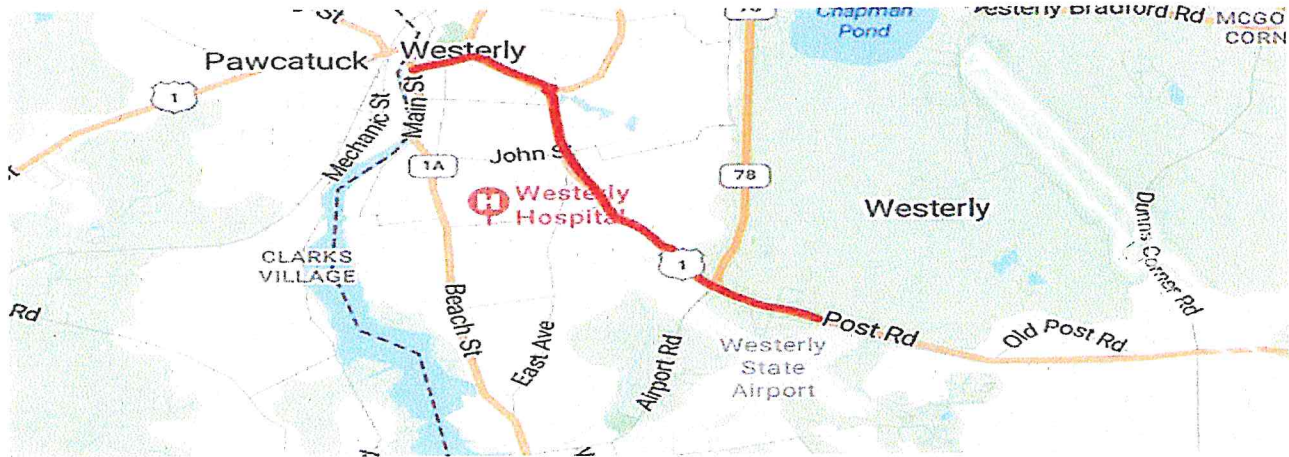


Pavement Improvements US Route 1 Westerly



What's happening?

The Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) is improving and replacing roadway pavement, reconstructing drainage structures and installing concrete sidewalks in certain areas. Additional work includes the installation of handicap accessible wheelchair ramps and manhole cover work. Paving work will take place in segments on US Route 1 in Westerly - Broad Street, Granite Street, and Franklin Street

When is it happening?

The paving plan in Westerly is as follows:

Mid July to Late July: Granite Street paving from Tower Street to East Avenue.

August : Broad Street paving from Union Street to Tower Street

Early October to Late October: Franklin Street Paving from East Avenue to Bellaire Street

This is night-time paving work with expected construction noise. Hours of operation are Sunday through Thursday from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM

Selected drainage, manhole cover, sidewalk and handicap accessible work will continue to occur during the daytime Monday through Friday 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM late June through September
